Hearing Aid Compatibility Report

PinPoint Wireless, Inc. (“PinPoint”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,¹ and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,² hereby files its Seventh Report detailing its compliance efforts with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. PinPoint is including in its Seventh Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can only be adequately answered by individual handset manufacturers.

I. Carrier Background

PinPoint is a small carrier that provides Commercial Mobile Radio Service (“CMRS”) in the Hastings - 185, North Platte - 325 and McCook - 270 BTAs using GSM technology in Nebraska, under FCC call signs KNLH671, KNLH681, WPOJ809, and KNLG235.

II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale

Of the handsets Pinpoint currently offers for sale, the following handsets have been certified by the FCC’s Office of Engineering and Technology as T-rated and/or M-rated hearing aid compatible (HAC):

III. Hearing Aid Compatible Handset Labeling/Insert Requirement

All of the HAC compatible handsets PinPoint offers for sale contain labels and inserts indicating the level of HAC compatibility of the handset.

IV. Outreach Efforts

PinPoint is educating its customers on the hearing aid compatible functionality of the handsets it sells, including providing customers with a list of hearing aid compatible handsets. In addition, Pinpoint has adopted a flexible thirty-day no questions asked return policy for consumers seeking to obtain hearing aid compatible GSM digital wireless handsets. PinPoint has posted signs in each of its retail store locations indicating which specific handsets are hearing aid compatible.
