Hearing Aid Compatibility Report

Lamar County Cellular, Inc. (“Lamar”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,¹ and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,² hereby files its Seventh Report detailing its compliance efforts with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. Lamar is including in its Seventh Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can only be adequately answered by individual handset manufacturers.

I. Carrier Background

Lamar is a small commercial mobile radio service (“CMRS”) carrier that provides GSM-based service in rural Texas.

II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale

Of the 12 total handsets Lamar currently offers for sale, the following 3 handsets have been certified by the FCC’s Office of Engineering and Technology as T-rated and/or M-rated hearing aid compatible (HAC):

Motorola V3 RAZR	(FCC ID IHDT56EU1)	M3
Motorola V3i RAZR	(FCC ID IHDT56GW1)	M3/T3
Nokia 6085	(FCC ID LJPRM-198H)	M3/T3

III. Hearing Aid Compatible Handset Labeling/Insert Requirement

All of the HAC compatible handsets Lamar offers for sale contain labels and inserts indicating the level of HAC compatibility of the handset.

IV. Outreach Efforts

Lamar has trained its key retail staff to educate its customers on the functionality of its hearing aid compatible handsets. In addition, Lamar has posted signs in each of its retail store locations indicating which specific handsets are hearing aid compatible. Lamar offers its customers a flexible return policy on its HAC-compatible handsets.
