Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 16, 2007, Andrew Jay Schwartzman and the undersigned of Media Access Project met with Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate. At this meeting, the parties discussed some of the issues raised in the above referenced proceedings.

With respect to the video competition proceeding, Mr. Schwartzman stated that data from multiple sources would support a finding that the level of cable penetration remains at or above 70%.

With respect to the leased access proceeding, the parties discussed the need for lower rates to promote independent programming, which is an important form of expression and diversity. Mr. Schwartzman also noted that the set-aside is congressionally mandated.
