Hearing Aid Compatibility Report

Texas RSA 7B3, LP d/b/a Peoples Wireless (“Peoples”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,¹ and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,² hereby files its Seventh Report detailing its compliance efforts with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. Peoples is including in its Seventh Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can only be adequately answered by individual handset manufacturers.

I. Carrier Background

Peoples is a small carrier that provides Commercial Mobile Radio Service (“CMRS”) in rural Texas.

II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale

Of the 6 total handsets Peoples currently offers for sale, all 6 handsets have been certified by the FCC’s Office of Engineering and Technology as T-rated and/or M-rated hearing aid compatible (HAC):

III. Hearing Aid Compatible Handset Labeling/Insert Requirement

All of the HAC compatible handsets Peoples offers for sale contain labels and inserts indicating the level of HAC compatibility of the handset.

IV. Outreach Efforts

Peoples is educating its subscribers and customers on the functionality of the hearing aid compatible handsets it sells. In addition, Peoples has a ten-day no questions asked return policy, as well as a flexible policy for its hearing impaired customers who purchase HAC compatible handsets. Peoples also posts signs in each of its retail store locations indicating which specific handsets are hearing aid compatible.
