Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Jane Mago, Ann Bobeck and the undersigned of NAB met with Rudy Brioche to discuss proposals for standardized and enhanced disclosure requirements for television broadcasters. We stressed the practical difficulties and burdens, especially for smaller stations, associated with placing a station's entire public file on the Internet, and explained why a requirement to place the political file on the Internet was particularly problematic. We also emphasized the difficulties associated with implementing any such requirement on short notice, especially during the on-going digital television transition when the financial and personnel resources of stations were already severely burdened. Finally, we discussed some of the practical problems likely to arise for licensees and the Commission if program reporting requirements were altered to focus on specific programming categories.
