

This is being filed in response to an email received today (November 28, 2007) from Shaun Maher of the Video Division, Media Bureau of the FCC. Mr. Maher inquired if KSBI-DT (Oklahoma City, OK) filed a request to extend its DTV "use it or lose it" waiver before November 18, 2007.

As counsel advised Mr. Maher, there is currently pending before the FCC a "Petition for Reconsideration" dated June 18, 2007 whereby Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. requests an extension of the "use it or lose it" waiver until February 17, 2009. Since the FCC has not yet acted upon the June 18, 2007 reconsideration request, procedurally a November 18, 2007 filing by Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. should not be required.

Please be advised that, on July 26, 2007, U.S. Senator Tom Coburn wrote to Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. to say that his inquiry of this matter revealed that the FCC would act upon the reconsideration request soon. But, no such action has taken place yet.

Accordingly, please be sure to associate the June 18, 2007 reconsideration request with KSBI-DT's records in this proceeding.
