On November 27, 2007, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”), met with Lisa Fowlkes, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (the “Bureau”).

The CTIA representatives discussed the Commission’s June 8, 2007 Order implementing the recommendations of the Hurricane Katrina Independent Panel. Specifically, CTIA addressed the Bureau’s implementation and activation of the 911 and E911 reports contemplated under Section 12.3 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 12.3. CTIA indicated wireless carriers’ willingness to provide relevant information concerning the redundancy and reliability of those 911/E911 network elements within their control.
