Dear Ms. Dortch:

The purpose of this notice is to memorialize a brief telephone conversation between Commissioner Adelstein and myself on November 27, 2007.

The principal purpose of the telephone conversation was to discuss a different matter. At the end of that discussion, Commissioner Adelstein asked my opinion about a recently circulated proposal pertaining to the terms of waivers that might be ordered for the Tribune Company and Samuel Zell. I urged him not to support waivers based on the description he afforded. I said that the notion of basing waivers on the fact that a particular cross-ownership was grandfathered was fundamentally at odds with the rationale of the FCC's 1975 decision as affirmed by the Supreme Court. I also pointed out that Tribune and Zell had requested temporary, not permanent waivers.
