
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's Rules and the FCC's Public Notice DA 07-1947, released May 10, 2007, of a meeting on November 28, 2007, with Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate. Present at the meeting were John R. Feore, Jr. and M. Anne Swanson representing Samuel Zell and EGI-TRB, L.L.C., two of the proposed transferees of the Tribune Company.

During the meeting, the participants discussed the current state of the newspaper industry and the continuing economic and competitive pressures facing the Tribune Company, the pending waiver requests of the Tribune Company and the procedural interplay of any waivers with a new cross-ownership rule that may be adopted by the FCC, and the Tribune Company's desire that it be allowed to close in a timely manner and given the opportunity to come into compliance with any new or modified cross-ownership rule.
