Request for Extension of DTV Build-Out Deadline

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Colins Broadcasting Company (“Colins”), permittee of KSNB-DT, Superior, Nebraska (the “Station”), by its attorneys, hereby respectfully requests an extension of the Station’s waiver of the Commission’s July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline. Due to litigation and severe financial constraints that continue to affect the station, Colins still cannot construct the Station’s full DTV facilities.

**Request for Confidential Treatment**

The Commission has authorized extension requests of the DTV construction deadlines based on an applicant’s financial condition. In recognition of the sensitive nature of an applicant’s financial data, the Commission has stated that applicants submitting financial information “that is proprietary and not customarily disclosed to the public . . . may request that the Commission treat the information as confidential.”<sup>1</sup> The Commission’s Rules state that materials including financial information that “would customarily be guarded from competitors . . . will not be made routinely available for inspection.”<sup>2</sup> The information included


