CTIA understands that the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (the “Bureau”) is currently drafting the reporting parameters associated with the implementation and activation of the 911 and E911 reports contemplated under Section 12.3 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 12.3.
