On December 6, 2007, Michael Rosenthal and Holly Henderson of Southern Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a SouthernLINC Wireless, and Christine Gill and David Rines of McDermott Will & Emery, LLP met with Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor to Chairman Kevin J. Martin, regarding the Commission's proceeding on the reexamination of roaming obligations of commercial mobile radio service providers.


In this meeting, we discussed SouthernLINC Wireless' views and positions regarding the extension of automatic roaming obligations to non-interconnected services, as set forth in SouthernLINC Wireless' comments and reply comments on the Commission's *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM)* in this proceeding. We also discussed SouthernLINC Wireless' position regarding Sprint Nextel's request for reconsideration of the inclusion of push-to-talk (PTT) services in the scope of the automatic roaming rule, consistent with SouthernLINC Wireless' Opposition to Sprint Nextel's Petition for Reconsideration.

Finally, we briefly discussed SouthernLINC Wireless' status with respect to the reconfiguration of the 800 MHz band.
