Dear Mrs. Dortch:

On Tuesday, December 11, 2007, Lawrence R. Sidman of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP, on behalf of Clear Channel Communications, Inc., met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Rudy Briocche, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein, to discuss several proposals currently before the Commission to increase minority- and women-ownership of media properties. Specifically, I explained how repeal of the AM/FM radio ownership subcaps would create genuine, immediate and more affordable opportunities for increased diversity of ownership of radio properties. I cited Multicultural Radio Broadcasting, Inc.'s December 10, 2007 and October 23, 2006 filings urging repeal of the subcaps, as well as the November 20, 2007 Supplemental *Ex Parte* Comments of the Diversity and Competition Supporters ("Diversity Supporters") in these dockets. I also communicated Clear Channel's support for the revised and more narrowly tailored trial incubator program advocated by the Diversity Supporters in their November 20, 2007 Supplemental *Ex Parte* Comments. I emphasized how approval of these measures could yield the tangible increases in minority ownership of media properties recognized as an imperative on a broad, bipartisan basis.
