On December 10, 2007, Chris Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, and David Redl, Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, met with Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor to Chairman Kevin J. Martin, to discuss the Commission's pending item on commercial mobile service alerting and to discuss CTIA's pending Petition for Declaratory Ruling regarding the use of wireless repeaters and jammers. As indicated in the attached presentation, CTIA urged the Commission to act on commercial mobile alerts consistent with the Final Recommendations of the Commercial Mobile Service Alert Advisory Committee and consistent with prior CTIA advocacy. CTIA also urged the Commission to continue to uphold its ban on the sale or use of wireless jammers except the sale to and use by the Federal Government, consistent with the second attached presentation.
