Dear Commissioners:

Earlier today, undersigned counsel filed a letter with the Commission on behalf of the thirty-four named State Broadcast Associations addressing the Report and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Broadcasting Localism appearing on the Agenda for FCC adoption at the Open Meeting on December 18, 2007. A supplement was filed adding the support of four additional Associations.
