On Friday, December 13, 2007 and today, Will Johnson and the undersigned of Verizon, and Fran Malnati of Verizon Wireless met separately with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein, John Hunter, Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell, Chris Moore, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tate, and Scott Deutchman and Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisors to Commissioner Copps, to discuss the above proceeding. The purpose of the meetings was to encourage the FCC to adopt reasonable reporting requirements that balance the need to obtain more useful deployment information while minimizing any additional burdens on reporting entities, the need to treat wireless carriers differently due to the mobile nature of their customers, and the necessity of maintaining strict confidentiality provisions. Verizon also discussed federal legislation that recently passed the House which would require the FCC to obtain data on various speed tiers, the types of technologies used to deploy broadband, and the number of subscribers on a 5-digit zip code basis. The attached Verizon Wireless enhanced services coverage map was used during the discussions.

All positions discussed are consistent with those Verizon has placed on the record in the above proceeding. Please let me know if you have any questions.
