

Dear Commissioners:

On December 14, 2007, undersigned counsel filed a letter with the Commission on behalf of the thirty-four named State Broadcast Associations addressing the Report and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Broadcasting Localism appearing on the Agenda for FCC adoption at the Open Meeting on December 18, 2007. Two supplemental letters were filed that same day adding the support of six additional Associations. This letter is to notify the Commission that the name of the Texas Association of Broadcasters was inadvertently left off the initial filing. Thus, a total of 41 State Associations, expressed their concern regarding the localism item which was on the Commission agenda on Tuesday, December 18, 2007.
