



C. The Technology Plan for 2001-2003 (attached) was submitted to Region One, they sent our technology plan to Region 13. We contacted Region 13 (Ms. Vicky White) asking for a copy of approval (See Attachment 3)

Whereas, IRRA sent our Technology Plan to appropriate and required entities, these entities have not been able to find copy of the approval letter in question.

We respectfully request that non-basic FRNs: #608340, #608395, #608364 be approved based on the documentation and evidence indicating that all processes were followed in our quest to secure USAC E-Rate funding of these FRN's for 2001-2002 program year.

Further, make this recommendation noting that it was not until the 5th Report & Order that the FCC required that applicants retain the technology plan and technology plan approval letter for a period of five years. This Order applied to FY2004 and later and was not given retroactive treatment to 2001. Moreover, the FCC's Brownsville Order issued on March 28, 2007, granted 32 appeals filed seeking waivers of the tech plan requirements, because the rules regarding technology plan requirements were not clear. The FCC found that the violations cited were also procedural in nature and not substantive.


