

On behalf of Jason Rodriguez, the Licensee of Radio Station WAMM (AM), Woodstock, Virginia, we hereby submit these brief comments in support the proposal to allow for the us of FM translators by AM stations. WAMM is the only owned hispanic radio licensee in Virginia's Shenandoah Valley. WAMM operates on 1230 khz at 1kW day-night. Although its daytime signal is listenable, WAMM's night signal is very poor. The ability to broadcast 24-hours a day in the FM band would be significant for this the Licensee and the valley's Latino community. The Licensee therefore supports the FCC's proposal to allow AM Licensee's to operate FM translators.
