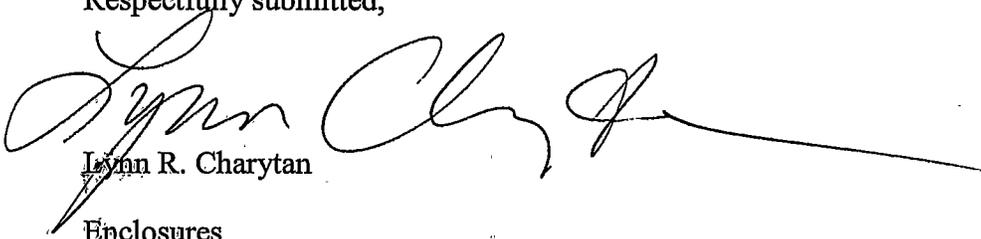

On December 14, 2007, the Staff requested additional information from Liberty Global, Inc. ("LGI") about the following topics:

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LGI Board of Directors And Executive Committee. LGI is a publicly-traded Delaware corporation, listed on the Nasdaq, with several thousand shareholders. The governing body of LGI is the Board. All major strategic commercial decisions, including approval of the budget, approval of the business plan, approval of major acquisitions and divestments and the issuance of stock, are decisions that must be made by the LGI Board.

The LGI Board is composed of ten members. Under Nasdaq rules, a majority of the members of the Board must be independent directors. Independence under these rules focuses on independence from the management and therefore on the relationship between the individual director and the company, including commercial, industrial, accounting, consulting, legal, charitable and familial relationships.
