RE: Withdrawal of the Domestic Application in the Joint International/Domestic Application for the consent to a Transfer of Control of OneEighty Networks, Inc., Transferor to Orbitcom, Inc., Transferee in WC Docket No. 07-286 and ITC-ASG-20071204-00483

Dear Ms. Dortch;

Pursuant to my conversation with Jodie May of the Wireline Competition Bureau, OneEighty Networks, Inc. (OneEighty) and Orbitcom, Inc. (Orbitcom) provide the following additional information and confirmations to support the withdrawal of their Domestic 214 Transfer of Control Application in WC Docket No. 07-286.

The transaction is a merger where OneEighty is merging into Orbitcom resulting in a transfer of control under Section 214 of the Telecommunications Act. The merged company is retaining all employees, including management, as well as the trade name OneEighty Networks. The corporate entity of OneEighty Networks, Inc. is dissolving.

It was originally thought that OneEighty had domestic private line services, however this proved to be in error. OneEighty and Orbitcom confirm that OneEighty is not providing telecommunication services and has no domestic subscribers. OneEighty provides Internet and data related services only.

OneEighty is not providing international services, however they wish to assign their International Section 214 authority to Orbitcom and is not withdrawing their International Application in Docket ITC-ASG-20071204-00483.
