I wish for this to serve as an official complaint against Sirius Satellite Radio. This is as briefly put as I can make it; however, there is far more to this than what I am about to describe.

Sirius radio advertised a full rebate on the purchase of a radio with the activation of same for current subscribers. I called Sirius to have someone assist me with the process. I did exactly as I was instructed, only to find out "just after the expiration" of the program that she advised me to send the wrong paperwork. Sirius admits that I was eligible for the rebate but refuses to honor their advertisement. Instead their response was basically if I didn't like it I can shut off my accounts (I have three and have been a subscriber for over a year). They did offer a \$20.00 rebate and after a week or so of repeated contacts, they added a \$10.00 credit towards my next subscription renewal "for my trouble." Why in the world would I want a \$30.00 offer when they should be sending a check for \$119.99? I have copies of all the advertisements as well as copies of their emails backing up my complaint and now they refuse to acknowledge my continued requests for a further review higher up the chain of command. Sirius radio effectively has stolen \$119.99 from me through false advertising and incompetent employees on the telephone. I now wonder how many others have been taken in by their misleading advertisements. They have displayed to me a total disregard for their customers and consumers in general. I shudder to think what will happen if they combine with XM Radio to corner the market and gain a monopoly in satellite radio. I can go into a more detailed explanation if you wish and provide all the documentation I have if you can investigate. I would be totally against the merger of Sirius and XM Radio, if anybody cares for another opinion. At least with two companies, we have an option in response to this kind of con-job.
