Re: Emergency Request for Waiver (CC Docket No. 02-6)

To whom it may concern:

Friedman Computer Solutions is requesting an emergency waiver. We sold a video distribution system to Barclay Elementary School under E-rate contract Form 471: 477964, FRN: 133177. Based on contact with USAC, it was noticed that items were invoiced but not installed in the time required due to no fault of ours. We were requested by USAC to return the funds we received for this project. Repayment was made but the school is using the equipment and we would have to remove the equipment if a waiver is not granted.

Baltimore School District instructed Barclay School to not allow us to reenter the building as they wanted to take over control. We were told that BCPSS would finish so we invoiced USAC as our role was completed. We later learned from USAC that BCPSS did not finish installing the equipment. We then spoke to the new IT director at BCPSS and were given permission to return and complete the installation. The school is extremely happy with the product which they are now using. We are now requesting a waiver of delivery deadline so we can recoup this money and avoid having to uninstall and remove the video system from the school.
