On Tuesday, January 22, 2008, Steve Largent, President and CEO, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, Chris Moore, Legal Advisor to the Commissioner, and Wayne Leighton, Advisor to the Commissioner to discuss various wireless industry policy issues. Parties at the meeting discussed the accelerating pace of innovation in the United States wireless industry. CTIA described how the competitiveness of the United States wireless market continues to deliver incredible benefits to consumers. In the face of these positive developments, CTIA expressed its concerns about recent proposals to regulate open device and application access and to otherwise regulate wireless carriers' network management practices. CTIA also described carriers' efforts to balance management of network resources to deliver quality wireless service and consumers' desire for more "openness."
