Fred:

I know that both Charlie and I left you voicemails at the end of the week regarding the referenced matter. And I can assure you that neither of us is trying to bug you. Yet, with this being a short week, there is precious little time to address the relief that we have requested, and we want to assure that if the relief is not granted it is not due only to the passage of time. We also understand that, ultimately, the call on this matter will be either yours or the Chairman's.

The bottom line here is that we genuinely believe that all will be better served if the Aloha/AT&T assignment application is put on PN this week as GRANTED, and that such action can be taken without requiring that a lot of work be done. Grant is critical to Aloha investors who need certainty before knowing how much to invest in the upcoming auction. We suspect that AT&T needs the same information, but do not speak for them. We also believe that all other bidders deserve certainty on this matter so that they can factor that into their bidding. Lastly, we believe that it would be a shame were something to transpire in the auction that would cause some third party to make a late submission in conjunction with this assignment application. That could move this proceeding from one where all that is needed is a simple grant PN to one that may tie the staff up with having to draft a decision.
