On January 24, 2008, Robert W. Quinn, William Drexel and I engaged in discussions with Commissioner Deborah Tate and Commissioner Tate's Legal Adviser for wireless issues, Wayne Leighton. During those discussions, we walked the Commissioner and Mr. Leighton through the spectrum aggregation detail and Aloha license location information both contained in AT&T's Public Interest Statement. In addition, we discussed DOJ status and timing details from other spectrum and wireless acquisitions. We also explained why there was no competitive impact resulting from this spectrum acquisition.
