

Dear Ms. Shetler:

I write on behalf of AT&T Corp. in connection with the above-captioned proceeding. Although he suggested, in a January 11th letter to you, that he would conclude his filings in this matter with one final, and short, summary, Mr. Inga has continued his practice of repetitive filings. Today, he submitted a request that AT&T withdraw its sanctions motion insofar as it is directed against him personally, that certain AT&T lawyers state whether *they* wish to continue to seek sanctions against him, and that various AT&T lawyers apologize to him for statements in various AT&T's briefs. In addition, Mr. Inga again accuses AT&T's lawyers of "intentionally" lying to the Commission and to various courts, and now accuses some of "ethics violations."

These utterly reckless and baseless accusations simply underscore, once again, the propriety and the necessity of sanctioning Mr. Inga personally. Accordingly, AT&T will not withdraw, in any respect, its sanctions motion.
