Dear Secretary Dortch:

In accordance with the 2nd Report and Order in PS Docket No. 06-229; WT Docket No. 96-86, the Region 12, 700 MHz Planning Committee submits the accompanying modified plan for your approval.

Region 12 is relying on the Computer Assisted Pre-Coordination Resource and Database System (CAPRAD) to supply the frequency tables, and therefore requests a limited waiver of 90.527(a)(3) and (6). Region 12 will submit the additional information as soon as CAPRAD has been updated.

The Region 12 modified plan was submitted electronically to the membership, and received approval through electronic polling. The plan was then submitted to the surrounding regions for concurrence. To date, Region 12 has received concurrence letters from Regions 43 & 46. Accompanying this letter is the email sent to the surrounding region chairs requesting concurrence. Region 12 requests a temporary, limited waiver of the adjacent region concurrence requirement for those regions that have not yet responded, and will submit the concurrence letters as soon as received.
