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FEE SCHEDULE

Presence in any court room, whether as an expert or witness of fact, \$300 hourly.

Testifying and making deposition(s), whether as an expert or witness of fact, \$300 hourly.

Preparation for testimony and case review, regardless of setting, \$140 hourly.

Traveling between court and his office, \$70 hourly.

Consulting with attorneys and/or officials related to the court, \$140 hourly.

Out-of-pocket expense associated with court work will be back-billed, including expense for lodging, mileage, parking, ferry fees, tolls, meals, tips, rental cars, and related expenses.

Treatment, Consultation, and Evaluation, \$140 hourly

The above-stated fees will apply unless Dr. Allmon participates in court room testimony or makes deposition(s) following less than three weeks advance notice to him, regardless of reason(s) for any delays in notification(s). If Dr. Allmon testifies following less than three weeks advance notice to him, he will charge a flat rate of \$300 hourly for all time associated with the testimony, including time allocated to preparation, travel, waiting to testify, conferring with attorneys, and/or preparing statements or letters.
