PETITION FOR LEAVE TO FILE A "SECOND SUPPLEMENT"

Holston Valley Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of Television Broadcast Station WKPT-TV and WKPT-DT, Kingsport, Tennessee ("Holston" or "WKPT"), by its attorney, hereby respectfully files this Petition for Leave to File a "Second Supplement" in the above-entitled proceeding. The "Second Supplement" pleading is being electronically filed within the same hour as this petition. In so doing, the following is shown:

1. Holston timely filed a "Petition for Reconsideration" in this matter, and also filed a "First Supplement" (and a motion for leave to file the same) on

November 8, 2007. As of this writing, we are unaware of any oppositions to either the Petition or the First Supplement.

2. After further study and a fuller appreciation of its options to provide digital television service to the people of the Tri-Cities region in northeast Tennessee and southwest Virginia after February 17, 2009, it was determined that the best way to proceed into the post-transition period is to remain on WKPT-DT's current transition channel, Channel 27, with the facilities that are installed and operating on Channel 27. The Supplement confirms this choice and reaffirm that this requested relief serves the public interest, convenience and necessity.

WHEREFORE, Holston Valley Broadcasting Corporation urges that this Petition for Leave to File a "Second Supplement" **BE GRANTED** and that the accompanying "Second Supplement to Petition for Reconsideration to Seventh Report and Order" **BE ACCEPTED AND CONSIDERED**.
