Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 5, 2008, Dan Hesse, President and Chief Executive Officer, Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint Nextel") and Lawrence Krevor, Vice President, Government Affairs – Spectrum, Sprint Nextel, met with Chairman Kevin J. Martin and his legal advisors, Ian Dillner and Aaron Goldberger, to discuss 800 MHz reconfiguration.

Messrs. Hesse and Krevor confirmed Sprint Nextel's commitment to reband the 800 MHz spectrum. They noted the substantial progress in reconfiguration: ninety-five percent of the nearly 1,200 Channel 1-120 licensees to be retuned in Phase I of 800 MHz band reconfiguration have been already been retuned. Over 100 public safety licensees in Phase II have been retuned to their new channel assignments and more than 500 of the 900 non-border area public safety licensees to be retuned in Phase II have signed and are implementing Frequency Retuning Agreements. They also explained why Sprint Nextel is seeking court review of the Commission's *Third Memorandum Opinion and Order* in the 800 MHz proceeding.
