Yesterday, Dee May and Will Johnson of Verizon met via conference call with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, to discuss the above-captioned proceeding. As the Commission considers reforms to its broadband reporting requirements, Verizon urged the Commission to weigh the usefulness of more granular broadband data against the additional burdens on both the Commission and broadband providers of providing and processing such data. Verizon encouraged the Commission to ensure that any new reporting requirements are reasonable and result in information that is useful to the public and the Commission, but also to collect this information in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

All positions discussed are consistent with those Verizon previously has placed on the record in this proceeding. Please let me know if you have any questions.
