Notice of Oral *Ex Parte* Communication

RE: Amendment of Parts 1, 21, 73, 74 and 101 of the Commission's Rules to Facilitate the Provision of Fixed and Mobile Broadband Access, Education and other Advanced Services in the 2150-2162 and 2500-2690 MHz Bands, **WT Docket No. 03-66**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Today, Terri Natoli of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire"), a licensee, lessee, and operator of 2.5 GHz spectrum in the Broadband Radio Service (BRS) and Educational Broadband Service (EBS), met with Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor in the Office of Commissioner Robert McDowell and Bruce Gottlieb, Wireless and International Legal Advisor in the Office of Commissioner Michael Copps. The purpose of the meeting was to urge the Commission to act on the outstanding issues in the above-referenced proceeding as soon as possible so as to provide greater certainty and stability for the 2.5 GHz industry. Clearwire explained that these outstanding issues, which were raised in various petitions for reconsideration and/or clarification of the Commission's April 27, 2006 Orders in this proceeding, have been pending now for more than 18 months. Clearwire also urged the Commission to expedite the re-auctioning of the forfeited Broadband Radio Service Basic Trading Area authorizations as called for by the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. (WCA) in its September 12, 2007 *ex parte* letter to Chairman Martin to further facilitate wireless broadband deployments in the 2.5 GHz band. The views expressed by Clearwire in this meeting are all a matter of record in this proceeding.
