**COMMENTS**

George S. Flinn, Jr. ("Flinn"), by his attorney, hereby respectfully submits the following comments in support of the Federal Communications Commission's December 21, 2007 "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" proposing the allotment of Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee:

1. Flinn was the winning bidder in Auction 70 for authority to construct a new FM station on Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee (i.e., MM-FM578-A). Thereafter, Flinn timely filed (a) an FCC Form 301 application proposing to reallocate Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee to Channel 264C3 at Waynesboro, Tennessee and (b) a Petition for Rulemaking seeking the allotment of Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee (i.e., to prevent removal of Linden's first potential local service).

2. On December 21, 2007, the FCC issued a "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" seeking comment on the proposed allotment of Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee.<sup>1</sup>


<sup>1</sup> It should be noted that, as part of the proposal, a show cause order was directed to Flinn Broadcasting Corporation noting the proposed change in channel for WYDL (FM), Middleton, Tennessee from 264C3 to 262C3. Flinn Broadcasting Corporation is wholly owned by the petitioner/commenter, George S. Flinn, Jr. It is

Flinn incorporates herein by reference his previous applications and filings in this matter and affirmatively restates his present intention (i) to apply for Channel 267A at Linden, Tennessee if it is allotted,<sup>2</sup> (ii) to participate in any auction therefor, and (iii) to build the station promptly if awarded the Channel 267A, Linden, Tennessee construction permit at auction.
