On February 15, 2008, the undersigned and Peter Corea of ICO Global Communications (“ICO”) met with Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps. ICO reiterated its comments filed on December 19, 2007, addressing the “consensus plan” and joint petition for waiver of Sprint Nextel Corporation, the Association For Maximum Service Television, Inc., the National Association of Broadcasters and the Society of Broadcast Engineers (collectively, “Sprint-BAS Parties”), filed in the above-referenced proceedings on December 6 and September 4, 2007, respectively.

ICO noted that the Sprint-BAS Parties and the 2 GHz MSS operators are actively engaged in discussions regarding the BAS transition implementation and deadlines. As background, ICO submitted a summary description of pertinent issues in the BAS relocation proceeding, which is attached to this filing.
