This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on February 15, 2008, Ben Scott of Free Press and Professor Tim Wu of Columbia University met with legal advisors Ian Dillner and Aaron Goldberger for Chairman Kevin Martin. On the same date, we met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein along with his legal advisors Rudy Brioche and Scott Bergmann.

We briefly discussed the substance of the petitions filed by Free Press and other consumer organizations in the aforementioned dockets. We also discussed the Commission's field hearing on broadband network management practices scheduled for February 25, 2008, at which Professor Wu was requested to make a presentation. We offered our own thoughts on experts that the Commission might wish to consult in conjunction with issues up for discussion at the Boston hearing. We conveyed our support for the public hearing and the involvement of scholars, engineers, innovators, and consumers outside of Washington in these important policy decisions.
