On February 19, 2008, the undersigned and Peter Corea of ICO Global Communications (“ICO”) met with Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology (OET), and Nicholas Oros of OET. ICO reiterated its comments filed on December 19, 2007, addressing the “consensus plan” and joint petition for waiver of Sprint Nextel Corporation, the Association For Maximum Service Television, Inc., the National Association of Broadcasters and the Society of Broadcast Engineers (collectively, “Sprint-BAS Parties”), filed in the above-referenced proceedings on December 6 and September 4, 2007, respectively.

ICO noted that the Sprint-BAS Parties and the 2 GHz MSS operators are actively engaged in discussions regarding the BAS transition implementation and deadlines.
