Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 22, 2008, James W. Cicconi, Senior Executive Vice President-External and Legislative Affairs, on behalf of AT&T Services, Inc. (AT&T), and Thomas J. Tauke, Executive Vice President - Public Affairs, Policy and Communications, Verizon, met with Chairman Kevin Martin and Daniel Gonzalez. The discussion focused on reasonable broadband network management practices and wireless early termination fees. With respect to reasonable network management practices, Messrs. Cicconi and Tauke reiterated the importance of flexibility to ensure an Internet that functions well for consumers. Messrs. Cicconi and Tauke also asked that the Commission preempt state regulation of early termination fees. Their statements were consistent with AT&T's and Verizon's positions as set forth in their filings in the above referenced proceedings.
