MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Lee County, Florida (the "County"), by its attorneys, hereby requests an extension of time in which it must submit a cost estimate to Sprint Corporation ("Sprint"), as set forth in the Federal Communications Commission (the "Commission") Public Notice FCC 07-168, released September 12, 2007, "FCC Announces Supplemental Procedures And Provides Guidance for Completion of 800 MHz Rebanding" (the "Notice"). Therein, the Commission required that the National Public Safety Planning Advisory Committee ("NPSPAC") licensees in Wave 3 complete planning and submit a cost estimate to Sprint no later than December 15, 2007.

The County is the licensee of WPUJ906, WNRC465, WPUP324, and WPUK283. The licenses provide service to 6,780 subscribers. Despite the diligent efforts of the County, the County was unable to submit the Frequency Reconfiguration Agreement ("FRA") by the December 15 deadline contained in the Notice due to Motorola's failure to provide requisite information required for inclusion in the FRA in a timely fashion. Issues which currently remain

outstanding include but are not limited to those in connection with RIB Boards, WAN Router and Rebanding Filter Kits.

Despite the County's continued efforts, Motorola has not yet provided the requisite information and has now advised the County that Motorola will not submit a cost estimate to the City until March 20, 2008. In addition, the County is still awaiting the final language for the FRA with Motorola.

Therefore, the County respectfully requests an extension to April 4, 2008, in order to allow Motorola to complete and submit its documentation to the County for County review. The public interest would be served by this extension as it would allow more careful planning of the rebanding of the frequencies utilized by public safety subscribers.


