Yesterday, the undersigned, together with Anna Miller and Indra Chalk of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) and Charles McKee and Rosemary Emmer of Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”), met with Julie Veach, Amy Bender, Ann Stevens, Tim Stelzig, Melissa Kinkel, and Marilyn Jones of the Wireline Competition Bureau. Scott Freiermuth of Sprint Nextel participated by telephone.

The parties discussed issues raised in the above-referenced petitions relating to local number portability. Specifically, T-Mobile and Sprint Nextel applauded the Commission’s recent *Declaratory Ruling, Order on Remand, and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* mandating four-field validation requirements for ports. The parties agreed that additional “provisioning fields” are necessary to accomplish a port and urged the Commission to require prompt development of standardized “provisioning fields” to effectuate simple intermodal and wireline-to-wireline ports.
