On February 27, 2008, Kathleen O'Brien Ham and Patrick Welsh of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") and Harold Furchtgott-Roth and the undersigned, on behalf of T-Mobile, participated in, and Jim Martinek and Heather Stacy of T-Mobile attended by telephone, a meeting with Fred Campbell, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("Bureau"), Paul Murray, Legal Advisor to the Bureau, John Branscome, Chief of the Spectrum and Competition Division ("Division") of the Bureau, and Christina Clearwater of the Division regarding the above-referenced docket on wireless roaming matters.

The T-Mobile representatives specifically discussed why the Commission should reconsider the "home market exclusion" to the new automatic roaming requirement that was adopted in the 2007 *Roaming Order*.¹ The T-Mobile representatives expressed views that were consistent with its petition for reconsideration of the *Roaming Order* and other filings that it has submitted in the roaming proceeding. The T-Mobile representatives also relied on the attached presentation.
