On March 4, 2008, I met with Rudy Brioche, Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein's legal advisor, on behalf of Capitol Broadcasting Company, Inc. We discussed the following two issues in the above-referenced dockets:

- The need for Commission guidance related to privacy issues if viewer e-mails are available online to comply with the Commission's new rules on placing television station public files on the Internet.
- General concerns related to a permanent community advisory board as proposed. Capitol supports the ascertainment process, but believes that it is better to meet with a wide cross-section of the community as opposed to one group of individuals on a regular basis.
