On March 4, 2008, the undersigned, as counsel to Crown Castle International Corp. (“Crown Castle”), spoke with Joel Taubenblatt, Acting Deputy Chief of the Commission’s Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. In our discussion, I suggested that fundamental principles of spectrum management, including market-based principles of regulatory parity, and service and technical neutrality, espoused consistently by the Commission for several years, dictate that Section 27.50(f)(1), the fixed and base station power limit rule applicable to commercial operations in the 1670-1675 MHz band, be modified to allow operations pursuant to the Power Spectral Density (“PSD”) proposal outlined in comments and reply comments filed by Crown Castle in this proceeding. Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission’s rules, I am filing this notice electronically in the above-referenced dockets. Please contact me directly with any questions.
