On February 14, 2008, City of Boston and Sprint Nextel Corporation filed a Joint Status Report to inform the Presiding Judge that the 800 MHz Transition Administrator ("TA") reviewed and approved their Frequency Reconfiguration Agreements ("FRAs").

On February 15, 2008, the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") filed its Comments on the FRAs, wherein it stated that the Bureau has no objections to the FRAs approved by the TA.

Accordingly, in accordance with *Order* FCC 07M-49, released November 15, 2007, it is now appropriate and timely for the parties to submit a Joint Motion to Terminate, signed by each of the parties to this proceeding.
