ORDER OF TERMINATION

On February 21, 2008, Nextel Communication, Inc. ("Nextel"), City of Boston ("Boston") and the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau"), filed their Joint Request for Termination of Proceeding ("Termination Request").

The parties represent that Nextel and Boston have prepared and executed Frequency Reconfiguration Agreements ("FRAs"), and reached an accord on all outstanding disputed issues which would have to have been resolved in this proceeding. *See Hearing Designation Order* (DA 07-1631), 22 F.C.C. Rcd. 6778, released April 5, 2007 (issues set for litigation following unsuccessful mediation between Nextel and Boston).


Rather than undertake costly and time consuming litigation, Nextel and Boston submitted FRAs to the Commission's 800 MHz Transition Administrator ("TA") which the TA approved on February 6-7, 2008. Following the TA's approval and in accordance with *Order FCC 07M-79*, released November 15, 2007, the Bureau filed Comments stating that it has no objection to the FRAs as approved.

The parties now represent in the Termination Request that there are no remaining issues requiring resolution in this proceeding, and that in accordance with the Presiding Judge's *Order FCC 08M-10*, released February 20, 2008, the parties request termination of this proceeding.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Request for Termination of Proceeding filed on February 21, 2008, IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this proceeding commenced under *Hearing Designation Order* DA 07-1631, (PS Docket No 07-69, Mediation No. TAM-11155), released April 5, 2007, IS TERMINATED.
