On Wednesday, March 12, 2008, Karlen Reed, Regulatory Counsel, and Scott Reiter, Director of Industry Relations, with the National Telecommunications Cooperative Association (NTCA), met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and his Legal Advisors Scott Bergmann and Renée Crittendon. We discussed issues raised in NTCA's reply comments concerning the support for CMAS alert, PS Docket No. 07-287; the cost and implementation time for 9-digit zip code implementation for Form 477 data collection for broadband mapping, WC Docket No. 07-38; and the cost of changing lighting systems regarding the tower lighting and migratory birds, WT Docket No. 03-187. NTCA also responded to the Commissioner's request for information regarding census tract mapping techniques and provided the two attached examples drawn from Yellowstone County, Montana and Middlesex County, Massachusetts. The discussions were consistent with NTCA's positions in previously filed comments and pleadings in the above-referenced dockets.
