Dear Ms. Dortch,

This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on March 13, 2008, Ben Scott of Free Press met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein as well as legal advisors Rudy Brioche and Scott Bergmann concerning the above mentioned proceedings.

We discussed the substance of the petitions filed by Free Press and other consumer organizations in the aforementioned dockets. In particular, I presented a verbal summary of Reply Comments filed on February 28, 2008 by Free Press et. al.

We also discussed the Commission's field hearing on broadband network management practices that took place on February 25, 2008. I pointed out that the arguments and evidence presented by MIT professors were consistent with our Reply Comments in this proceeding. I reiterated that we are not opposed to network management practices in general, but we are strongly opposed to the particular practice of targeting and blocking applications. I also noted our desire to see the Commission pursue anonymized network traffic data of the type requested by the MIT engineers. I conveyed our support for the Cambridge public hearing and any further involvement of scholars, engineers, innovators, and consumers outside of Washington in these important policy decisions.
