Bresnan Communications, LLC ("Bresnan") submits this letter in lieu of reply comments to support its first amended Request for Waiver filed in this proceeding on December 14, 2007. The Media Bureau issued a Public Notice in this proceeding on February 27, 2008 that afforded the public until March 18, 2008 to file comments on the amended waiver request. No party filed comments. Because Bresnan has demonstrated that its request meets the legal requirements and the Commission's precedent for the requested waiver, and also that a waiver would serve the digital transition, the goals of the Act and the public interest, and because its request is unopposed, the Commission should grant the requested waiver as soon as possible and without waiting for the conclusion of the time period afforded to Bresnan to file reply comments.¹
