Dear Ms. Desai:

On January 22, 2008, Mediacom Communications Corporation (“Mediacom”) filed a request for expedited waiver of Section 76.1204(a)(1) of the Commission’s rules to allow it to continue to deploy low-cost, limited function integrated set-top boxes in certain cable systems that Mediacom commits to upgrade to all-digital operations by February 17, 2009. Mediacom’s waiver request was placed on public notice on February 27, 2008. Pursuant to Section 76.7 of the Commission’s rules, the deadline for filing comments or oppositions to Mediacom’s petition expired on March 18, 2008.

To the best of Mediacom’s knowledge, no oppositions or comments were timely filed with respect to its petition. In light of this fact and the fact that Mediacom has previously demonstrated that grant of its request would serve the public interest and is consistent with Commission precedent and given Mediacom’s need to begin the process of transitioning the communities covered by its waiver request to all-digital operations as soon as possible, Mediacom hereby submits this letter in lieu of reply comments and asks that the Commission grant the requested waiver without any further delay.
