On Tuesday, April 1, 2008, Jessica Marventano, Senior Vice President of Government Relations for Clear Channel Communications, Inc. (“Clear Channel”), and Lawrence R. Sidman of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP met with Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, to discuss Clear Channel’s concerns regarding the proposed merger of XM Satellite Radio and Sirius Satellite Radio. Clear Channel elaborated upon its Comments filed in this proceeding on July 9, 2007 and August 13, 2007.

Specifically, Clear Channel discussed conditions that should be imposed on a merger of XM and Sirius in the event the Commission approves the proposed transaction. A copy of those conditions were provided during the meeting and are attached hereto. Clear Channel also discussed the shortcomings of the Department of Justice Antitrust Division’s March 24, 2008 decision to close its investigation of the proposed merger.
